

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF BILTMORE FOREST
TO ADOPT THE COUNCIL-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Biltmore Forest, at a regularly scheduled meeting on April 11, 2017, adopted a Resolution of Intent to Consider an Ordinance Amending the Charter of the Town of Biltmore Forest to Adopt the Council /Manager form of Government (the "Amendment") and scheduling a public hearing on the Resolution of Intent;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on the proposed Amendment on May 9, 2017, no members of the public or citizens of the Town opposed the proposed Amendment, and the Board of Commissioners desires to finalize the Amendment;

BE IT NOW ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Biltmore Forest:

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of G.S.160A-101 and 160A-102, the Charter of the Town of Biltmore Forest, as set forth in Chapter 32 of the 1923 Session Laws of North Carolina, as amended, is hereby further amended to provide that the Town shall operate under the council-manager form of government in accordance with Part 2 of Article 7 of G.S. Chapter 160A and any charter provisions not in conflict therewith.

Section 2. The Town Clerk shall cause a notice to be duly published, stating that an ordinance amending the Charter to adopt the council-manager form of government has been adopted. Subject to any referendum petitioned for and conducted pursuant to G.S. 160A-103, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 24, 2017.
